VINEYARD:

Eighty percent of the grapes are from relatively cool sights, the exception being the Rutherford vineyard (moderately warm) and Atlas Peak (moderately cool).

AROMAS:

Black cherry, blueberry, cassis, toasty oak.

TASTE:

The entry is full and round with mouth-filling tannins. The evolution has a strong presence throughout the entire pallet without being overly heavy. This is a powerful yet balanced wine with a long finish. A classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon.

WINEMAKING:

Hand-harvested / 11-30 day macerations / Gentle handling / 20 months in barrels / 3-day cold soak / Minimal manipulation
