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## HIGH ROLLER 2013 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

### PASO ROBLES



#### VINEYARDS

Meticulously managed, our estate Paso Robles vineyards afford us continuity of wine style and quality with each vintage. This wine region is known for its extreme growing conditions (fifty degree temperature variances from morning to afternoon are not uncommon), with sparse moisture and well-drained, gravelly soils. The Cabernet from our Paso Robles vineyards is wonderfully fruit forward, rich, intense and concentrated with ripe, velvety tannins. The High Roller Cabernet is gently crafted to be a true varietal expression, with a genuine sense of place.

The High Roller Cabernet comes from our two Paso Robles vineyards: Firehouse Vineyard and Branch Road Vineyard. Both get enough heat during the day to fully ripen the rich flavors of the region, yet remain cool enough at night to balance out a natural acidity and smooth flavor profile.

#### VINTAGE

The 2013 vintage was characterized by cool mornings which gave way to warm, sunny afternoons. A long, slow growing season with few heat spikes allowed the grapes to ripen to perfection. A rain-free fall meant we could pick the grapes at the ideal point of sugar ripeness and tannin balance.

#### WINEMAKING

We picked individual vineyard blocks with the perfect balance between ripeness, sweetness, acidity and flavor, 100% destemmed and then fermented them separately in stainless steel tanks. The wine went 100% through the Malolactic fermentation before being racked down to the cellar to age. The lots were then oak aged with a mix of French and American oak to integrate the cask aged characters with the robust berry aromas and flavors. Patient months of aging have yielded “elevage” characters of leather, black tea and ripe berry flavors.

#### WINEMAKER'S TASTING NOTES

Our flagship wine is crafted for those who “go big”, at the dining table as well as the game table. This hearty cab stands up and demands notice. It's the perfect complement to a thick porter house steak or the celebration in your comped suite after you've made the house feel a little pain.

The High Roller Cabernet's deep, inky ruby color gives a hint of the flavors in store...bold, ripe fruit aromas followed by cocoa, black peppercorns and leather. Explosive flavors of macerated red berries, dried cherries and ripe black currants follow. Texturally, the powerful attack, round mouth-feel and lush tannins add up to a spectacularly bold Cabernet.
